

# Notice of Race

## 12ft skiff Interdominion Championships - 2006

1. **Date:** The regatta will be conducted from the 7<sup>th</sup> January to the 14<sup>th</sup> January 2006

**Organising Authority:** The Auckland Sailing Club

**Venue:** The landing Okahu Bay

2. **Rules**

The regatta shall be governed by the current rules as defined in the RRS 2005-2008, the prescriptions of Yachting New Zealand and by the sailing instructions.

3. **Eligibility and Entry**

The regatta is open to all 12ft skiffs that are registered with the NSW 12ft skiff sailing association, Qld 12ft skiff sailing association or the NZ 12ft skiff sailing association.

Eligible boats may enter the regatta by completing the official entry form available from Auckland Sailing Club or downloading the same form from [www.skiff.org.nz](http://www.skiff.org.nz).

Entries will be accepted during registration times listed below. A fee of NZ\$200 must accompany all entries and must be received no later than 1000hrs Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> January.

The entry fee includes a CD of regatta photos, regatta tee shirt, regatta entry and presentation lunch.

4. **Advertising**

The regatta is classified as a category B event in accordance with RRS 79 and Appendix 1.

## 6. Measurement

Random checks may be carried out at any time during the regatta including weight at the discretion of the race committee.

## 7. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available at Auckland Sailing Club from Thursday the 5<sup>th</sup> January and will be handed out with acceptance of entry.

## 8. Racing Area

The racing area will be on Auckland harbour. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

## 9. Scoring

Silasec trophy: the low point scoring system shall apply  
John Brook Teams: as outlined in the Interdominion constitution.

## 10. Alternative Penalties

The 720 penalty turn, 44.1 of the racing rules will apply, except that the 720 is replaced by a 360 degree turn.

## 11. Protests

Protest mediation will be used prior to any formal protest hearings. Protests shall be conducted in accordance with the RRS Part 5.
