NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1** Advertising will be allowed up to and including Category C.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1** The regatta is open to boats of the 12 Foot Skiff class that comply with the measurement rules of the Association.

4 FEES

- 4.1** A \$20 “on the day” entry fee will accompany each skiff entry to the Championship unless interclub series payment of \$50 (which includes entry to all programmed interclub events) has been paid to the NSW 12 foot Sailing Skiff Association.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1** Date 22nd March 2009.
- 5.2** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the race is 1425 (2:25pm)

6 MEASUREMENTS

- 6.1** Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1** Sailing Instructions and will be available at <http://www.skiff.org.au> or from the club on the day.

8 VENUE

Sydney Flying Squadron, 76 McDougall Street, Milsons Point, NSW.

9 THE COURSES

9.1 These will be included the sailing instructions.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

11 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be given as follows: 1st, 2nd and 3rd on Fastest and 1st, 2nd and 3rd on Association Handicap.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUS\$5 million.
