NOTICE OF RACE

INTRODUCTION

The Sydney Flying Squadron is hosting the 2006 Port Jackson Championship and invites all registered 12 foot skiffs to compete.

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (2005-2008) and the prescriptions of the AYF , the rules of the NSW 12ft Sailing Skiff Association and by the sailing instructions and attachments.

VENUE

Sydney Flying Squadron, 76 McDougall Street, Milsons Point 2061

RACING AREA

The races will be conducted on Sydney Harbour in the area bounded from the Sow and Pigs to Kirribilli Point.

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

The skiff must be a registered 12 ft Skiff and comply with the measurement rules of the N.S.W. 12ft Sailing Skiff Association.

All entries for the regatta must be received by the Officer of the day before 12.30PM on Sunday 25th March 2006.

FEES

A \$20 "on the day" entry fee will accompany each skiff entry to the Championship unless interclub series payment of \$50 (which includes entry to all programmed interclub events) has been paid to the NSW 12 foot Sailing Skiff Association.

ADVERTISING

Advertising will be allowed up to and including Category C.

ORGANISING AUTHORITY

Sydney Flying Squadron on behalf of the N.S.W 12 Foot Sailing Skiff Association.

SCHEDULE

Sunday, 25th March, 2006. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the race is 1430 (2:30pm).

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at www.skiff.org.au or on the day from the club.

SCORING

The Bonus Point System of Appendix A will apply.

PENALTY SYSTEM

Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

PRESENTATION

A presentation of trophies will take place on the balcony of the club as soon as possible following the race.

PRIZES

Trophies and Prize money/Prizes will be given as follows:
Championship 1st, 2nd, 3rd placing's.
Overall Handicap 1st, 2nd, 3rd placing's

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUS\$5 million.
